**BOLT BUS COMPANY RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, The office of the Deputy Mayor did not come before the ANC 5B to express interest in the Crummell School Parking Lot for use of hosting lay over for the Bolt Bus Company.

**WHEREAS**, No representative of the Bolt Bus Company came before ANC 5B to present plans of future use of the Crummell School Parking Lot.

**WHEREAS**, The Crummell School is cited as a historical preservation.

**WHEREAS**, D.C. Official Code §1-309.10 (d) (3) (A) states that, "The issues and concerns raised in the recommendations of the Commission shall be given great weight during the deliberations by the government entity. Great weight requires acknowledgement of the Commission as the source of the recommendations and explicit reference to each of the Commission's issues and concerns."

It is hereby **RESOLVED** that,


**THEREFORE**, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 5B strongly urges the Deputy Mayor's Office and the Department of Transportation not to allow the operation of Bolt Bus Company to utilize the Parking Lot of Crummell School in the Ivy City Community. It will add to the unwanted traffic and pollution to the Ivy City community. It will add to the negative impact to the community. None of the residents of the Ivy City community will receive any on the job training.

**THEREFORE**, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 5B strongly opposes the office of the Deputy Mayor and Department of Transportation and its Director decision to relocate the Bolt Buses to the Crummell School parking without coming before the ANC5B, which is not in compliance with D.C. Official Code §1-309.10 (d)(3)(A), regarding ANCs' being given "great weight".

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code §1-309 *et seq.*, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 5B expects its considered opinion expressed in this resolution to be given great weight by the Deputy Mayors office and Department of Transportation. To the extent that the Deputy Mayor office disagree with Advisory Neighborhood Commission 5B the Deputy Mayors office must provide their reasoning in writing addressing the concerns raised by Advisory Neighborhood Commission 5B with specificity and particularity.
