about the Union Station "Master Plan"

Ivy City residents have filed a lawsuit against Mayor Gray and the Union Station Redevelopment Corporation to stop the planned bus depot which would have 65+ charter buses coming in and out of the community each day, where they would park at the cherished historic landmark Alexander Crummell School. The city moved forward with these plans without adequate community input, with no environmental impact study, and against the city's own planning documents which call for the site to be restored for job training and community use.

Ivy City is one of DC's most historic African American communities. It is a low income community that DC continues to dump on. In fact the small community already has 10 acres of parking lots to house the city's school buses and DPW truck fleet. The community suffers high rates of asthma and other respiratory illness, and is actively working to IMPROVE the quality of life in the neighborhood - yet the city continues to dump on it!
