**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF
ADVISORY NEIGHBORHOOD COMMISSION 5B
OPPOSITION TO THE PROPOSED USE
OF THE HISTORIC ALEXANDER CRUMMEL SCHOOL
PARKING LOT BY BOLT BUS COMPANY**

WHEREAS, it does not appear that Advisory Neighborhood Commission 5B has been given sufficient notice or afforded adequate opportunity to examine the parties involved in the proposed use of the Crummell School Parking lot in connection with the operation of the Bolt Bus Company;

WHEREAS, the Crummell School has been cited as a historical landmark and such use destroy the historical integrity of the property and will negatively impact the surrounding community from both a safety and health standpoint exacerbating unwanted traffic problems and contributing to environmental and pollution hazards for the Ivy city community;

WHEREAS, is opposed to this proposed operation because it offers no known positive benefits: recreational, economical, employment or otherwise, for the Ivy City community or District residents; and

WHEREAS, D.C. Official Code §1-309.10 (d) (3) (A) specifically states that, "The issues and concerns raised in the recommendations of the Commission shall be given great weight during the deliberations by the government entity".

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT ANC 5C, voted unanimously to indicate our opposition to this unilateral action and call upon the City, the Deputy Mayor, and the Director of the DC Department of Transportation to cease and desist any further discussions, negotiations or contractual agreement with Bolt Bus Company and immediately began the process of obtaining public input by meeting with residents of ANC 5B and Ivy City to hear their concerns and develop a viable, workable solution to this problem.

Advisory Neighborhood Commission 5C is composed of twelve (12) Commissioners and therefore seven (7) Commissioners constitute a quorum. On July 17, 2012, at a duly noticed public meeting of ANC 5C, nine (9) Commissioners were present and voting. The Commission voted unanimously to approve this Resolution. We therefore certify the information contained in this letter to be true and correct.
